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BATCH OF 2000 - SILVER JUBILEE

On 26th July 2025, Crescent campus came alive as the 2000 pass-out batch returned for their Silver Jubilee Reunion, organised with great care by the BSA Crescent Alumni Association. The celebration began on the University campus, where alumni wandered familiar corridors and revisited their classrooms, before continuing for the next two days at Radisson Resort. Over 300 alumni from more than 15 countries joined the three-day celebration, bringing with them a wave of nostalgia, laughter, and cherished memories.

The day at Crescent began under the **banyan tree**, a place close to the hearts of the alumni. They walked through the corridors, sat in their old classrooms, and posed for photos, all while discovering the many changes that had come to the University. At the same time, the reunion-built bridges across generations. Alumni interacted with about 80 final-year and pre-final-year students from 8+ departments, and one such interaction even led to a student receiving an internship with a stipend of Rs. 30,000 per month, followed by a confirmed job in Singapore.



One of the most special parts of the event was the way teaching and non-teaching staff were honoured. Around 40 non-teaching staff members were invited with printed cards and sweets from Gupta Bhavan, and each one of them received a memento on the day. Many were touched by this gesture. A non-teaching staff member from the Department of Commerce said she had never been honoured in such a way in her entire career, calling it "*a surreal experience*".

The evening was full of fun, with stand-up comedy, music, and dance. **Comedy actor Mr.Jayachandran** brought extra joy to the crowd at Radisson.

Group photos, return gifts, and a donation of Rs. 2,00,000 as sadaqah fund to the BSA Crescent Alumni Association made the celebration even more meaningful.

The event was attended by **Mr. Ahmed Buhari**, Member of the Board of Management, and **Dr. N. Raja Hussain**, Registrar. Their support and encouragement added to the warmth of the occasion.

What made the reunion shine was not just the scale of it, but the feelings it carried, gratitude, and a deep bond with Crescent. GENAI FOR GENZ



The “GenAI for GenZs” workshop was conducted on August 20, 2025, by the Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre (SPDC) at B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science & Technology. The one-day program held in IT Department Lab III from 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM and was led by **Mr. Raja CSP Raman**, Co-Founder of Kactii and Founder of Featurepreneur. Nearly 70 students participated in the workshop, which was designed to give students a solid introduction to the world of Generative AI in a way that was both informative and fun.

The event was organized under the guidance of Dr. N. Prakash (Professor & Head/IT) as the convener, with Dr. S. Subhashini, Mr. V. Niaz Ahmed, and Ms. P. Sakthi serving as coordinators, managing the session efficiently.

Unlike a typical lecture-based workshop, this workshop stood out because of its gamified approach, which included contests, challenges, and prizes for winners that kept everyone engaged throughout the day.

The resource person, Mr. Raman, brought in his rich background in AI and machine learning. He has authored multiple research papers and has worked in areas like AI monitoring, developer analysis, technology trend prediction, and secure AI solutions. He shared not just theories but also real-world insights, which made the workshop relatable and practical. During the session, they walked through important concepts like understanding a **Generative AI Agent**, the process of **independent agent making**, and how the **Model Context Protocol (MCP)** helps models handle and

context effectively. Apart from these, there were also technical challenges that pushed students to think creatively and apply what they had learned. Students were recognised with awards



such as the Half-day Performer Award, which boosted motivation, while quirky highlights like the phrase “Just Kimi it” added a playful twist that made the learning more memorable. Overall, the “GenAI for GenZs” workshop successfully combined theory with practice, knowledge with fun, and left participants with a clear understanding of Generative AI and the confidence to explore its possibilities further.

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
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SCHOLARSHIPS



The Chevening Scholarship at the University of Buckingham

The Chevening Scholarship at the University of Buckingham provides full funding including tuition fees, living allowance, and airfare for Master's programs in Chevening-eligible subjects. Open to candidates from Chevening-eligible countries, applicants must have completed an undergraduate degree equivalent to a UK 2:1 honors, possess a minimum of two years (2,800 hours) of work experience, and commit to returning to their home country for at least two years after the award. The program, funded by the UK government and partner organizations, supports outstanding graduates with leadership potential to pursue one-year postgraduate studies in the UK.

The EIT Urban Mobility Master's Scholarship

The EIT Urban Mobility Master's Scholarship is offered by EIT Urban Mobility to support Indian students pursuing Master's degrees in fields such as Sustainable Urban Mobility Transitions, Smart Mobility Data Science & Analytics, and Business Engineering in Urban Mobility. The scholarship provides partial tuition fee funding along with an annual monthly allowance of €2,000, helping students finance their studies in Europe. Eligible applicants must be Indian nationals admitted to the EIT Urban Mobility Master School.
